- Flights and Visa
- Accommodation (costs covers 3 meals a day)

    - Single: 80 USD / night / person
    - Double:60 USD / night / person
  - Tegucigalpa
    - Single:130 USD / night / person
    - Double:110 USD / night/ person
  - o Kharkiv
    - Single: 75 EUR / night/ person
    - Double: 55 EUR / night/ person
- Course Fee: \$200 USD

The costs have to be paid in advance: No applicants will be allowed to follow the course otherwise.
