
The R&J Management guidelines details the R&J Pathway, and gives precise information on eligibility, and steps on advancing to each star level. This document also outlines the career options of an R&J after retiring.

The AIBA R&J Manual is a comprehensive document that should be used by R&Js to clearly understand AIBA rules and how to implement them. The manual also details important procedures and demonstrates proper hand signals.
